



CNB 76 - "ZAMPA"

This CNB 76 for sale is #4 of the successful and popular series. She has been in private ownership since new. She is well equipped with all the expected options and comforts on board including an all-furling rig with in-mast mainsail (with full vertical battens) and a hydraulic gangway. This CNB 76 has a customised interior layout with an office area in the saloon and the master cabin benefits from a large double on the centre-line facing aft. She is offered for sale ex VAT but she remains under a French lease which can be transferred to a qualified buyer giving VAT paid status in the EU.

The CNB 76 is a luxurious, spacious cruiser built by CNB in France. Modern, elegant design by Philippe Briand with a wide stern, chines, two rudder blades and vertical bow. The deck saloon ends behind the mast and foredeck is completely flush. This gives the CNB 76 her sleek profile and elegant appearance. With a large, longitudinal tender garage, the fantastic, bright deck saloon, a clever four-cabin layout with owner's cabin forward and the spacious asymmetrical cockpit the CNB 76 was an extremely popular model. A very clever arrangement of the galley and crew area with direct cockpit access leaves the owner and their guests completely undisturbed and detached from the functional areas on board.

CONSTRUCTION

The hull and structural bulkheads are made of vacuum infused PVC foam / glass / carbon and resin sandwich Watertight bulkheads forward and aft – bulkheads are laminated and/or bonded to hull and deck

Deck made of composite/PVC foam sandwich is vacuum infused

Deck beams are carbon fibre reinforced

Keel fitted to the hull with s/s bolts

Twin hanging rudders with vacuum infused rudder blades, s/s rudder stocks and JP3 bearings

Vectran cable on aluminium quadrant

Opening transom/swim platform giving access to longitudinal 3.45m tender garage

Light grey gelcoat finish on hull

INTERIOR & ACCOMMODATION

Sleeps eight in four cabins plus single berth crew cabin in forepeak

- Bunk cabin to starboard midships with lower bunk extendable into double, en suite bathroom and storage, bathroom can also be accessed as a day bathroom from the corridor
- Double cabin aft to port with en suite bathroom and storage
- Lee cloths fitted to all berths
- All bathrooms with Corian countertops and electric freshwater flush toilets

Machine room


